WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan (Deemed University), Ekalavya Campus, C/o. Swami Vivekanand Mohavidyalaya, P.O.-Fatikchara, Via-Kamalghat, Mohanpur, West Tripura, Agartala, Tripura-799210 has submitted an application (**Code No.ERCAPP1728**) to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for conducting **Shiksha Shastri. Course** with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) by online on (mm/dd/yyyy) 12/30/2012 and hard copy of application submitted on (mm/dd/yyyy) 1/8/2013.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Secondary Teacher Education (Shiksha Shastri) programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan (Deemed University), Ekalavya Campus, C/o. Swami Vivekanand Mohavidyalaya, P.O.-Fatikchara, Via-Kamalghat, Mohanpur, West Tripura, Agartala, Tripura-799210** for conducting **Shiksha Shastri. Course of Secondary (level) of one year** duration with an annual intake of **100 (one hundred)** from the academic session **2014-2015** under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.

4. The recognition is subject to fulfillment of the following:

- (i) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.

- (iv) All such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

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- (v) The institution shall submit the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- (vi) The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
- Copy of the Application Form
  - Land and Building Particulars
  - Staff Profile
  - Recognition letter
  - Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

5. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

6. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, they may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act in the "Online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days of the issue of the order.

Sir,

Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi (RSKS), a deemed university under the Ministry of Human Resource Development, is recognised by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and has been accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with 'A' Grade. RSKS was established in the year 1970 by the Government of India to preserve, promote and propagate the learning of traditional Sanskrit in India and abroad. RSKS has been declared as Deemed to be University vide Government of India & UGC Notification No. F.9-28/2000-U.S dt. 7.5.2002 and F.6.91/2001 (CPP-D) dt. 18.6.2002 respectively. RSKS is fully funded by Govt. of India.

2. RSKS conducts the examinations from Prathama (8<sup>th</sup> Standard) to Acharya (M.A.) level and also conducts Ph.D. programmes. RSKS has 10 campuses spread across the country and also have a number of institutes affiliated to it. RSKS conducts traditional Sanskrit examinations for the students in these institutes, in a centralised manner at New Delhi. The certificates/degrees awarded by RSKS are equivalent to the modern certificates/degrees awarded by other Universities/Boards/Examining Bodies situated in the country as under: -


