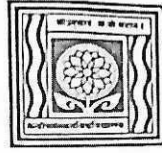


2. Further, various activities to be undertaken during this campaign for different Ministries have been mentioned. The actionable activities proposed for M/o Education, D/o HE is as below-
